

Car Share Guidance to minimise risk of transmission of Covid-19

Wherever possible car sharing should be avoided with people outside the household bubble.

If car sharing is necessary, please try to

- Share with only one other person
- All people in the car must wear face coverings
- Government guidance for car sharing also suggests where possible:
 - open windows for ventilation
 - travel side by side or behind other people
 - face away from each other
 - maximise distance between people in the vehicle
 - clean your car between journeys (especially door handles and other touchpoints)

Please follow this guidance to minimise the risk to yourself and your colleagues

Note- people who car share may be categorised as close contacts in the event of a positive case, by NHS Test and Trace.
